This rock is now called the "**ROCK**", but when I was a little boy, we called it "**THE ROCK OF GIBRALTER**" because it was so large. Actually, it is a very dangerous rock, and although children

love to slide down it's gentle eastern side, many have fallen off its other steep sides. The most common accident was a "broken arm", however head injuries frequently occurred. The Rock of Gibraltar is located on the south-east corner of third avenue and third street in Grand Beach Park. It is a historic landmark left behind by the Ice Age. Across the street on the north east corner was a cottage owned by the Richardson family, and they called it THE RICHARDSON BUILDING.
